

LICENSES . . .

Non-resident hunting licenses are not guaranteed. Non-resident deer and elk licenses must be applied for by April 1st. The deadline to apply for antelope licenses is June 1st. All applications MUST be done online via the Montana Fish, Wildlife and Parks website www.fwp.mt.gov or at an FWP office. Archery hunters will also need to purchase a bow and arrow license prior to archery hunting. With a written request, we will be more than happy to assist our clients with their license applications.



BOOKING TERMS . . .

We pride ourselves in wildlife management and therefore the number of hunters that we take is limited so please make reservations far in advance. At the time of booking your hunt we require \$1000 down to secure your deer / elk hunt and \$500 down to secure your antelope hunt. Our total deposit requirement is 50% of the cost of the hunt. Upon successfully drawing a license, the remaining portion of the 50% of the deposit is due May 1st for deer / elk hunts and July 1st for antelope hunts. The final balance for all hunts is due by August 15th. If you are not successful in drawing a license, your deposit can be refunded or carried forward to the next year. We accept cash, major credit cards, cashiers checks and money orders. Please note that we add 3.5% for credit card transactions.

WHAT TO BRING . . .

If archery hunting, please bring your bow and arrows of your choice. If rifle hunting, bring the scoped rifle and ammunition that you shoot the best. Most hunter's use mid-caliber (.257-.338). The average shot is 150-200 yards. Please bring a gun or bow case, personal effects, binoculars, and clothes that allow you to dress appropriately for the season. In Montana the weather is apt to change in the blink of an eye. Clothing should include: Jeans and/or wool or camouflage pants, wool or camo shirts, sweater, coat, heavy socks, hunting boots, that are well broken in, thermal long underwear, hat and gloves. And of course don't forget your camera to capture all the awesome memories!

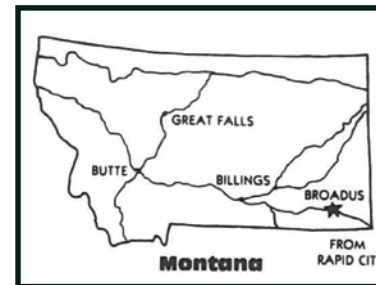
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COMBO HUNTS . . .

An exciting and versatile hunt and a good choice for hunters unable to hunt in Montana frequently. You will be allowed to harvest either a whitetail or mule deer and an antelope. Very respectable trophies can be taken on this hunt as it is not uncommon to see over 100 animals and sometimes more. Some of our biggest trophies are harvested during our early hunts.

TROPHY HUNTS . . .

After the opening hunts, the weather triggers the rut concentrating the game. Are you willing to endure the cold and hunt hard from sunrise to sunset? Can you pass up the smaller bucks you might see? If so, this is the hunt for you! Our local area is unique for several reasons. First, local game counts confirm that you can expect to see a very high ratio of non-typical mule deer. Best of all though is we have both large whitetail and mule deer bucks.

We adhere to the principles of "fair chase," but within these bounds, every effort is made to obtain the very best trophy available.



FACILITIES . . .

Our camp is rustic, but comfortable. We furnish all the equipment except personal effects necessary to make your hunt successful and enjoyable. Our trailers have heat/AC, showers, refrigerators and comfortable mattresses. Trailers can accommodate single hunters as well as large groups. Couples will have their own trailer and we generally don't have to combine hunters from different groups in the same trailer. All meals are prepared and served family style in the cook house. We pride ourselves in the fact that we serve good traditional home cooked abundant meals. If you leave hungry it is no one's fault but your own! If lunch is to be eaten in the field, your guide will pack a lunch.

Our camp is easily accessible. Commercial flights are available into Billings, MT, Rapid City, SD, and Gillette, WY. Rental cars are available at the airports to complete your trip to Broadus.

We care for your meat, trophy horns, and capes as if they were our own. The client covers the cost of freight, taxidermy, and meat processing. All meat processing will be done at the meat processor.

OUR HUNTING AREA . . .

Powder River Outfitters leases thousands of acres of prime hunting land in the South-eastern Montana. Rolling hills are cut by brushy draws and meandering creeks. The highest ridges are covered by pines but are easily accessible in a four wheel drive vehicle. WEATHER . . .

Old timers have always said that only newcomers and fools predict weather in Montana. Early archery season will likely be hot with the temperature decreasing as the season progresses. Rain and snow is apt to happen at any time and the wind will probably blow! When our rifle hunts begin we expect mid range temperatures during the days and freezing nights. As the season progresses the chances of cold snowy weather increases. We have archery hunted at both 100 degrees and freezing rain/snow. Rifle season has seen has seen 65 degrees to 45 degrees below. Come prepared for the worst and hope for the best!



BACK COUNTRY DEER & ELK CAMP . . .

Our camp is located in the Little Belt Mountains in the Helena - Lewis & Clark National Forest in Central Montana. From the trail head our pack mules and horses will take you and your gear on approximately a 5 mile ride to the base camp which is about 6000 feet. Base camp consists of a large cook tent, guide tent, sleeping tents, shower tent, and of course an outhouse! This camp is operated under a special use permit with the Helena - Lewis & Clark National Forest. This area is closed to all motorized vehicles so all hunting is done via horseback, mules, or simply walking. The terrain can be steep and rugged but also consists of open meadows surrounded by thick timber. Over 20 years ago, several thousand acres of the national forest were burned and the recovering area serves as an abundant feeding ground for the deer, elk, and some black bears. If you are looking for a true back country hunting experience, you will not be disappointed.

ARCHERY HUNTS . . .

We welcome bow hunters! As experienced bow hunters ourselves, we understand the conditions necessary for close range stalking and a successful hunt. Because of the size of the area, and the fact that we limit the number of hunters, our area is not over hunted. We can help you experience the ultimate challenge.
